Act 38	Prohibits local governments from requiring both electronic and paper UDC permit applications, and specifies acceptable paper application forms	11/21/19	AB 117	The ARC supported this legislation.
Act 39	Allowance of previous warning for fire, tornado, and school safety drills for public and private schools	11/21/19	AB 54	The ARC supported this legislation.
